Early Explorers (K-2)

Students will learn about plant/tree identification, bird identification, fish species (fishing/throwing a rod/reel without hooks), simple campfire cooking, campfire stories, gardening, and much more. Students will participate in hide & seek, I Spy Nature Trail, and other hands-on and exciting activities with safety as a top priority.

Nature Explorers (3-5)

Students will participate in some of the same activities as Early Explorers with the addition of archery, tent building, shelter building, canoeing, and kayaking. Other adventures will be added throughout the school year.

Leadership Adventures (6-8)

Students will participate in some of the same activities as younger explorers with the addition of survival skills, camping, canoeing, and kayaking. Food preservation and cooking activities will be included.

Wilderness Expedition (9-12)

Rock climbing, rappelling, cave adventures, and survival camping will be included for students who are ready for extreme adventure. Trips will be scheduled through True Adventure Sports in Ft. Payne, AL.
